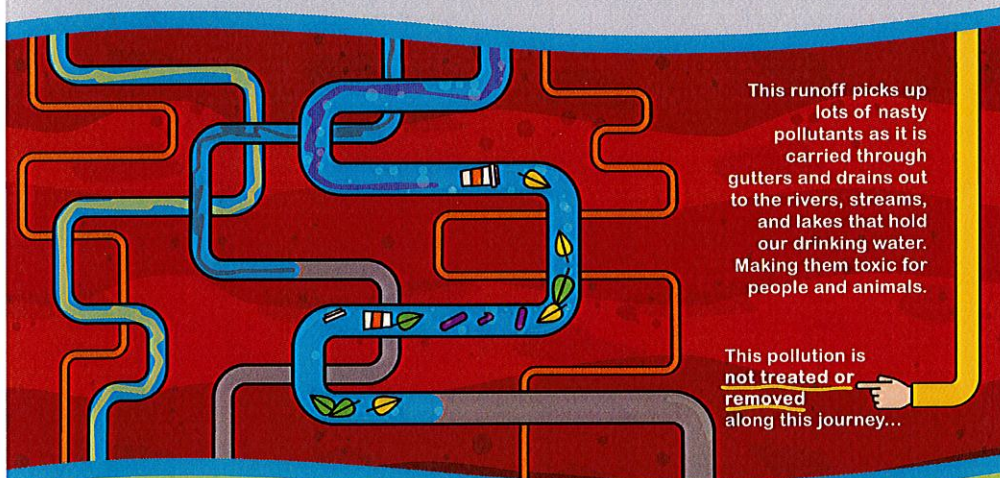


Save Our Water By Preventing STORMWATER POLLUTION
